



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**BETWEEN**  
**STATE ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY SUNAN KALIJAGA YOGYAKARTA**  
**AND**  
**FINLAND UNIVERSITY**

State Islamic University Sunan Kalijaga Yogyakarta, Indonesia and Finland University, Finland recognizing the benefits accruing to their respective universities by the establishment of strong international relationship hereby conclude this agreement.

1. The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational collaboration and to promote friendly relations between the two universities.
2. Both universities undertake to promote and develop cooperation with various activities such as those listed below, based on equality and reciprocity.

Based on the principles of mutual benefit and respect, both institutions intend to explore opportunities for:

- (1) Faculty and staff mobility between the two institutions
  - (2) Exchange credit earning of undergraduate and graduate students
  - (3) Professional Development opportunities for faculty and staff members
  - (4) Conducting of colloquia, lectures and seminars
  - (5) Other cooperation mutually agreed by both universities
3. In order to give effect to these forms of cooperation, representatives of individual faculties, schools and institutes within the two universities will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways mentioned in Clause 2 above.
  4. Both institution agree that specific projects and activities shall be developed for implementation of this Memorandum, based on discussions and negotiations between the two institutions. Agreements or contracts shall be signed separately to carry out these projects and activities.
  5. Both institutions agree that all financial arrangements shall be discussed and determined based on specific projects and activities and will depend on the availability of funding.



6. The implementation of the Collaboration as referred to above is subject to concluding separate written agreements where the content, scope, financing and other conditions regarding the respective items are agreed between binding the parties. This MOU does not, however, constitute any promise to enter into any such separate written agreement. In the case of reaching mutual agreement on the implementation of the Collaboration and the Items, details of Items shall be attached to this MOU and/or added as an Addendum.
7. This MOU shall be valid from the date of signature by each Party until 31.12.2023, unless, prior to such date, the Parties agree in writing upon extension or termination thereof.
8. This MOU is made in two identical originals, each one having equal force and effect. The parties to this MOU have read and understood its entire substance and acknowledge that all terms and contents in this MOU are important and correct. Any changes, additions and amendments to this MOU shall be made in writing. The parties hereby sign their names in the presence of witnesses and retain one copy each.
9. The parties agree that as an essential proposition to any cooperative endeavor, all participants in programs created pursuant to this Agreement will be selected with full respect for equal opportunity for all persons in accordance with the policies of each party and without regard to the race, sex, age, national origin or religious affiliation of participants or candidates for participation.
10. Both institutions agree that all specific financial agreements are to be negotiated separately for each component and are dependent on mutual interest and on the availability of funds from the public and private sectors, and/or international organizations. Each institution will designate a contact person to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.
11. Any difference or dispute that may arise out of the interpretation or application of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.
12. The agreement may at any time be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. It may be terminated within the period by either party giving six months' notice to the other.
